Ameena Ali

Ameena Ali, PhD. has for nearly three decades been on the front lines of health care and education. A former U.S. Army field paramedic, Dr. Ali now manages a network of wellness and maternal care services for women in crises.

The Atlanta-based entrepreneur is founder of the Georgia Reproductive Resource Alliance Center for Education and Empowerment (GRRACEE), a nonprofit umbrella for "A Mothers' Peace" and "C.A.R.E." (Cultural Awareness and Responsibility of Educators). The nonprofit provides education support services in the maternal care midwifery sector for doulas, apprenticing midwives and others seeking holistic education in pregnancy and childbirth education. Proctored by the "Village" approach in community outreach, Dr. Ali provides open-resource care to all who seek wisdom and "innerstanding" of proper mother-baby healthcare.

As a maternal support educator, Dr. Ali leads a wellness team in providing birth, labor and postpartum process (with education), prenatal services to the indigent, homeless, undocumented, incarcerated and religious clientele with cultural requests for birthing options being met.

The mother of two college age girls, Dr. Ameena is an "on the ground" activist supporting and giving voice to some of the most vulnerable members of society. Her aspiration is to found and operate a Village Birth and Maternal Wellness and Educational Center, a bartered co-op, for birth care, wellness, parental and childbirth education, instruction and indigenous studies, with domestic partners and international birth-helpers—the goal...to amass a formula for well mother-baby care that significantly reduces local and domestic infant-maternal mortality and morbidity rates. ▼
