His entire family transitioned to Islam proper under the leadership of Imam Warith Deen Mohammed.

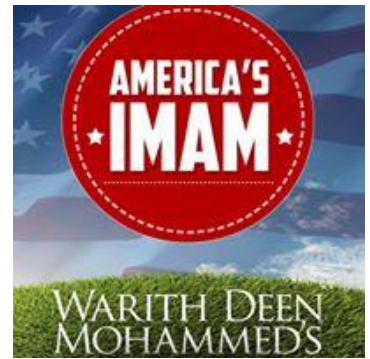
